# Precautions for daily use

### Observe the following items

#### Maintenance of the cabinet

- When cleaning the cabinet, use a soft cloth (made of cotton, floss, etc.) to clean gently. Do not use a dry
  or damp rag mixed with chemicals, as this could cause the ingredients of the cabinet body to deteriorate
  or crack.
- Be careful not to use an abrasive cloth for cleaning or clean with excessive force, as this could scratch the surface of the cabinet.
- If the cabinet is greatly soiled, clean with a soft cloth (made of cotton, floss, etc.) soaked with a small amount of diluted neutral detergent and wrung out, and then clean with a soft dry cloth.
- Because the cabinet is made of plastic, solvents such as benzene, alcohol or thinner could cause it to deteriorate, or make its coating come off. Therefore do not use such solvents to clean the cabinet.
- Because plasticizer is included in the plastics, deterioration or the coating peeling off could occur when
  the cabinet comes into contact with some substances. Therefore keep it away from volatile substances
  such as insecticide. In addition, do not let it come into contact with objects made of rubber, resin, etc. for
  a long time.

#### Maintenance of the LCD panel

- Before cleaning the LCD panel, be sure to turn off the TV set and unplug the power cord from the outlet.
- When cleaning the LCD panel, use a dry and soft cloth (made of cotton, floss, etc.) to clean the surface of the LCD panel gently. For protecting the LCD panel, do not clean with a dirty cloth, detergent, or a dry or damp rag mixed with chemicals, as this could cause peeling of the panel surface.
- Be careful not to clean with an abrasive cloth or with excessive force, as this could cause the panel surface to be scratched.
- If the LCD panel is greatly soiled, clean it gently with a soft cloth (made of cotton, floss, etc.) soaked with a small amount of water (Do not clean with excessive force, so as to avoid the scratch of the panel surface).
- If dust sticks on the surface of the LCD panel, clean the panel with a commercially available cleaning brush (anti-static brush).

# Important safety precautions

Cleaning — Unplug the AC cord from the AC outlet before cleaning the product. Use a damp cloth to clean the product. Do not use alcohol cleaners, spray cleaners or chemical cloth when cleaning because these types of materials may damage the product.



 Water and moisture — Do not use the product near water, such as bathtub, washbasin, kitchen sink, laundry tub, swimming pool and in a wet basement.



 Do not place vases or any other water-filled containers on this product. Do not place the product under air conditioner, humidifier and so on. The water may spill onto the product causing fire or electric shock.



• Stand — Do not place the product on an unstable cart, stand, tripod or table. Doing so can cause the product to fall, resulting in serious personal injuries as well as damage to the product. Use only a cart, stand, tripod, bracket or table recommended by the manufacturer or sold with the product. When mounting the product on a wall, be sure to follow the manufacturer's instructions. Use only the mounting hardware recommended by the manufacturer.



 When relocating the product placed on a cart, it must be moved with utmost care.
 Sudden stops, excessive force and uneven floor surface can cause the product to fall from the cart.



Ventilation — The vents and other openings in the cabinet are designed for ventilation. Do not cover or block these vents and openings since insufficient ventilation can cause overheating and/or shorten the life of the product. Do not place the product on a bed, sofa, rug or other similar surface, since they can block ventilation openings. This product is not designed for built-in installation; do not place the product in an enclosed place such as a bookcase or rack, unless proper ventilation is provided or the manufacturer's instructions are followed.



In case the product is dropped and the cabinet is damaged, be sure to turn off the power of the product, and unplug the power cord. If you continue to use the product, it may cause fire or electric shock.



 Do not open the rear cover of the cabinet to reconstruct the circuits. There exists high voltage within the cabinet and it may cause electric shock and injury. If maintenance is required, contact your dealer.



 The LCD panel used in this product is made of glass. Therefore, it can break when the product is struck forcefully or with a sharp object. If the LCD panel is broken, be careful/ not to be injured by broken glass.



 Heat sources — Keep the product away from heat sources such as radiators, heaters, stoves and other heat-generating products (including amplifiers)



 To prevent fire never place any type of candle or naked flames on the top or near the TV set.



 To prevent fire or shock hazard, do not place the AC power cord under the TV set or other heavy items.



 Do not place heavy objects on this product or stand on it. Doing so could cause injury if the product overturns. Take special care near children and pets.



 Unplug the power cord before you move the TV set. If not unplugged beforehand, the power cord may become damaged and cause electric shock.






# **Preparation**

### Attaching the stand unit

- When you attach the stand unit, put the TV on a flat surface.
- · Before attaching (or detaching) the stand unit, unplug the AC power cord from the AC power outlet.
- Before performing work, spread cushioning over the surface on which you will be laying the TV. This
  will prevent it from being damaged.


#### @ICAUTION

- Attach the stand unit in the correct direction.
- Be sure to follow the instructions. Incorrect installation of the stand unit may result in the TV falling over.
  - 1 Remove the stand unit parts and accessories from the packing bag and the whole machine is laid flat to distinguish the left and right bases and front and rear directions of the base mounting. Then insert the stand unit into the bottom of the back casing of the TV as indicated in the figure.




### Note.

- When installing the stand unit, it is required to place the front of the TV flat on the platform.Lay a layer of cushion on the platform before laying it flat.
- •To remove the stand unit, perform the above steps in reverse order.
- The stand unit does not allow adjustment of the angle.
- This product is not provided with a screwdriver.
- Be careful during the installation process to prevent your hands from being caught by the bottom of the TV and the floor.



Align the screw holes and then tighten with the 4 screws in the attachment.

### Handling and precautions with the wall-mounted TV







#### **OK** button:

- · After plugging in the power, press the **OK** button to turn on the TV from standby mode.
- In the power on state, press and hold for two seconds to display the simple option menu, select "
   (b) "and press the OK button to confirm, the unit enters the standby mode. (The functions of the simple option menu are from left to right: HOME, BACK, MENU, SOURCE, CLOSE, STANDBY, SETTING, VOL-, VOL+).
- $\cdot$  In "Simple Option Menu", press the OK button to confirm the operation.

#### Move the **OK** button up/down/left/right.

- . When there is a Option menu: Operate the option menu.
- Under the TV function, when there is no Option menu: Move the rocker up/down to switch channels; move the rocker to left/right to adjust the volume; Press the **OK** button to display the TV channel list.

### ♦ Note

- In case of 5 seconds no operation, it will automatically exit the simple option menu.
- To operate the smart mode, use the remote control.


### Before turning on the power

Instructions for setting the location of the TV

- Do not expose the TV to direct sunlight and keep it in a well ventilated area.
- Place the TV in a horizontal position.
- Do not turn on the power of the TV before connecting the AC power cord.
- If a protective film is attached to the casing of the TV, in order to ensure proper use of the unit, remove it before use.

### Connecting the antenna cable

In order to enjoy clear TV images, please apply the outdoor TV antenna. The following is a brief explanation of the types of connections that are used for coaxial cable.



- 2 Plug the TV's AC power plug into an AC outlet.



- Place the TV near an AC outlet and make the power plug easily plugged and removed.
- If you are not using the TV for a long time, unplug the AC power cord from the AC socket.

•To prevent the risk of electric shock, do not touch any uninsulated parts of the wiring when connecting the power cable.


### Connecting external devices


### Inserting the batteries

Before using the TV for the first time, insert two "AAA" batteries (supplied). When the battery is exhausted and the remote control is not operational, replace it with new "AAA" batteries.


1. Open the battery cover.



Insert the two supplied "AAA" size batteries.



3. Close the battery cover.



 Place batteries with their terminals corresponding to the (+) and (-) indication in the battery compartment.


#### **!CAUTION**

If the battery is used improperly, it may cause chemical leakage or explosion. Be sure to follow the instructions described below.

- Do not mix different types of batteries. Different models of batteries have different characteristics.
- Do not mix new and old batteries together. If a new battery is used in combination with an old battery, it will shorten the life of the new battery or cause chemical leakage in old batteries.
- When the battery is exhausted, remove the battery immediately. Chemicals leaking from the battery can corrode parts in the battery compartment. If any chemical is found to leak, wipe the chemical thoroughly with a cloth.
- Due to different storage conditions, the battery supplied with this unit may not reach the expected life.
- If you will not use the remote control for a long time, remove the batteries from the remote control.
- Do not expose the battery to excessive heat such as direct sunlight or fire.

### Using the remote control

When using the remote control, point it at the remote sensor. If there is a blocked object between the remote control and the sensor window, it may interfere with normal operation.



# Cautions regarding the remote control unit

- Do not place the remote control under severe vibrations.
   Also, do not immerse the remote control in a liquid or place it in a very humid place.
- Do not set or place the remote control in direct sunlight. Heat will cause the deformation of the remote control.
- The remote control may malfunction when the TV's remote sensor is exposed to direct sunlight or strong illumination. In this case, change the angle of the lighting or LCD TV, or operate the remote control near the remote sensor.



### **Preparation**

### Turning the TV on/off

#### Turn on the TV

After the TV is connected to the power supply, the TV is in standby mode.

Press  $\circlearrowleft$  (**POWER**) on the remote control of TV or the **OK** button on the TV:

• You can switch the TV into standby mode by pressing  $\circlearrowleft$  (POWER) on the remote control.

#### Turn off the TV

If it is already on, press  $\circlearrowleft$  (**POWER**) on the remote control or the **OK** button on the TV, select "STANDBY" in the rocker option menu:

- The TV is switched into standby mode and the image on the screen disappears.
- The power indicator will light up in blue. Press  $\Diamond$  (POWER) on the remote to turn the TV on again.
- If you need to turn off the power from standby mode, unplug the TV power cord.

### ♦ Note

- If you are not going to use this TV for a long period of time, be sure to remove the AC cord from the AC outlet.
- A small amount of electric power is still consumed even the TV is in standby mode.
- If the TV loses power in special circumstances(such as power outage or grid fluctuations, etc.), it may not work well when it is switched on again. Please try to power off the TV(by the  $\circlearrowleft$  (POWER) on the remote control) or unplug and replug the AC cord to restart the TV.
- It is a normal phenomenon when the TV temperature rises in the process of watching TV.
- Please do not cut off the power casually in the process of switching on or switching off the TV, running APPS or updating, otherwise TV system could not work correctly. Please turn off the TV after closing all APPS.

### **Picture**

- 1. Press the  $\equiv$  key on the remote control to display the main menu.
- 2. Press the </>
  /> key to select the main item "Picture" to be adjusted.
- 3. Press the ^/v key on the remote control to select the item you want to adjust; press the **OK** key to confirm the adjustment item or change the setting value.
- 4. If the adjustment item has a set value that can be adjusted, use the  $^{\/\/}$   $^{\/}$  key on the remote control;
- 5. Press the  $\equiv$  key again to leave this screen.

Picture mode	Press <b>OK</b> key to confirm and press  Mode: Standard/Soft/User/Bright.  At User mode, the value of Contrast, Brightness, Sharpness and Saturation can be adjusted.

- 4. Press </> key to adjust the setting value of the item.
- 5. Press  $\equiv$  key again to exit the menu screen.

### **Smart functions**

### **Basic operation**

Press the 🗅 key on the remote control to display the smart home screen (the smart home screen is subject to actual conditions).

- 1. Press the  $\wedge/\vee/\langle/\rangle$  key to select an App:
- 2. Press the **OK** key to execute:
- 3. Press the □ key to return to previous page.



In the smart mode, different applications and operating methods are also different. The operating methods described in this manual are for reference only. Please operate the machine according to the actual situation.



#### **Quick start**

Before using this machine, please understand the following operations for a better experience.

#### The operation of connecting mouse

- 1. Single click: click the mouse button and release it immediately:
- 2. Long press: hold down the mouse button for more than 3 seconds and then release it;
- 3. Single-clicking the left mouse button has the same effect to pressing the **OK** key on the remote control;
- 4. Single-clicking the right mouse button has the same effect to pressing the Return button on the remote control.

#### Language and input settings

Language setting: Select "Settings" > "Language & input", press the OK key, press the > key, press the ∧/∨ key, select the "Language", press the OK key, select the language you want in the displayed language interface, and press the **OK** key to select.

Select the input method: select "Settings" > "Language & input", press the OK key, press the > key, press the ^/v key, select the "Default", press the OK key, select the input method you want in the displayed interface, and press the **OK** key to select.

Set system time: In smart mode, select "Settings" > "Date & Time" > "Automatic date & time", press the **OK** key to check, the system will automatically get the time and update from the network, if your TV is not connected to the network, select "Automatic TV date & time".

#### **Smart functions**

### Setting

**Wireless and network settings:** Select the **Settings** in smart mode and press **OK** key to enter. **Wireless settings:** 

- 1. Select Wireless LAN, press the **OK** key, press the > key to select wireless network and press **OK** key to turn on the wireless network function, the unit automatically searches for nearby wireless network signals, and when the searched network has a **○** icon indication when it is displayed, the network can be connected without a password. When the searched network has the **○** icon, it indicates that the network is encrypted. You must confirm the correct password before connecting to the network. (Or select **○** in the upper right corner and press **OK** key, then select Scan, the TV will scan nearby wireless network signals)
- 2. Select the network you want to connect to in the network list and press the **OK** key.
- 3. Type the network connection password in the password box, select the Connect, and press the OK key to connect to the network:
- 4. If your router does not support automatic IP address acquisition, you need to select the **Show** advanced option, press the **OK** key to check, select static in the IP settings bar;
- 5. Confirm the IP address, gateway and other information; (IP address, gateway and other information can be obtained from the relevant network administrator)
- 6. When selecting a Connect, press the OK key to connect to the network.

#### Wired settings:

- 1. Select "Ethernet", press OK key, and then press > key;
- 2. Select "Proxy & IP Settings", set the proxy and IP address;
- 3. Select "PPPOE settings", press OK key, confirm the username and password, select "Connect", and press OK key to connect to the network.

#### Wireless hotspot

- 1. Select **More...**, press **OK** key, then press > key;
- 2 Select Portable hotspot and press OK key;
- 3 Select Portable Wireless LAN hotspot and press OK key to enable the WLAN hotspot function.
- 4. Select **Setup wireless LAN hotspot** and press the **OK** key;
- 5 Confirm the hotspot name in the Network SSID bar. The system defaults to "AndroidAP".
- 6.In the Security column, press the **OK** key to select the security type. If you do not need to set a password when you are an open network, select the security type None. However, any device that searches for your network can connect to your open wireless network. If you choose WPA PSK/NO/WPA2 PSK encryption, you need to confirm more than 8 protection passwords. Other devices search for your shared wireless network, you need to confirm the correct password to connect to your network.
- 7. The system will automatically configure a password for you. You can also type a password yourself in the password box.
- 8. Select **Save** and press **OK** key to save the settings. Other wireless devices in the area will search for your network when searching for wireless network.

### Other useful features


You can connect a USB memory device or a USB hard disk drive (HDD) to the TV to enjoy viewing pictures, listening to the audio, and watching videos.

### ⟨ Note

- Depending on the USB memory device, the TV may not be able to recognise the data.
- It may take time to read the data if the USB memory device contains many files or folders.
- External subtitles for some video files may not be supported.

### Connecting a USB memory device

Insert the USB memory device with recorded pictures audio or videos into the USB 1 or USB 2 terminal on the TV.



- The USB 1 and USB 2 terminals cannot be connected with USB hard disk drives at the same time.
- When connecting a USB hard disk drive, be sure to use a hard disk drive with an AC adapter.
- Do not remove the memory device from the TV while transferring files.
- Do not insert and remove a USB memory device/ USB hard disk drive to and from the TV repeatedly.
- When using a card reader, be sure to insert memory card first before using the card reader.
- The TV may not be able to recognise the card reader.
- Please follow the rules below when the TV is displaying the file of the USB device:
- —Please do not turn off the TV directly.
- —Please do not disconnect the USB device directly.
- —Please be sure to exit from USB interface before removing the USB device, otherwise you may lose the data, damage the device or TV system may not work properly.
- If the TV connects with USB-HUB, the TV may not be able to recognise all USB memory devices.

#### **!**CAUTION

- Do not use the USB extension cable, otherwise it may cause the TV does not work properly.
- Please insert the USB device after the TV is powered on properly.

# Playing back files on a USB memory device



- Press 🗘 on the remote control to enter the Smart Home Screen, select "Multimedia", then press **OK** key to enter.
- Press ^/~ key to select the device or drive you want to enter, then press **OK** key to enter.
- Press ^/∨ key to select the desired folder or directory and press **OK** key to enter. Press ^/∨ / ⟨ /> key to select the desired file, then press **OK** key to enter.
  - Select hey on the screen to exit to upper folder.

### **Troubleshooting**

The following problems are not always caused by malfunctions. Please check the TV again before having the TV serviced.

Problem	Possible solution
• No power.	<ul> <li>Is the AC power cord connected or not?(See page 11.)</li> <li>Is the main power turned on?(See page 15.)</li> <li>If the power switch does not work, unplug the power cord and plug it in, wait for more than 5 seconds, then press <b>OK</b> button on the TV.</li> </ul>
• The TV cannot be operated.	<ul> <li>External effects such as lightning, static electricity, etc., can cause malfunction. In this case, turn off the power of the TV, or unplug the AC power cord and wait for 1 to 2 minutes before reinserting before operating the TV.</li> </ul>
Remote control does not operate.	<ul> <li>Is the battery installed in electrode (+, -)?(See page 14.)</li> <li>Is the battery exhausted? (Replace it with new battery.)</li> <li>Is it used under glare or fluorescent lamp?</li> <li>Is there a fluorescent lamp that illuminates the remote sensor?</li> </ul>
Picture is cut off.	• Is the screen mode adjustment (such as image size) correct?(See page 16.)

#### Attention for use under high and low temperatures

- When the unit is used in a low temperature space (e.g. room, office), the picture may leave trails or appear slightly delayed. This is not a malfunction, and the unit will recover when the temperature returns to normal.
- Do not leave the unit in a hot or cold location. Also, do not leave the unit in a location exposed to direct sunlight or near a heater, as this may cause the cabinet to deform and the LCD panel to malfunction. Storage temperature: 20°C to + 60°C.




